EU High Level Policy Advisory Mission III (implemented by UNDP)

<u>Duration</u>: 1 January 2014 – 31 December 2015 (extension signed on 3 June 2015).

Budgetary allocation: EUR 3 Million

High Level Advisory Mission – Starting on beginning 2016

Mission under preparation

Main features:

- The new mission will be implemented by the EU Delegation to Moldova directly through a commercial service provider (NOT BY UNDP).
- The EU National Contact Points (NCPs) for Twinning and TAIEX will be the main contact persons between EU and Member States for the identification of suitable experts.

- The selection procedure will be done by the EU services with veto right by the Government of Moldova.
- Once selected, the commercial service provider will sign a service contract with the individual select high level advisers.
- Each high level adviser will be accompanied by a HLA Assistant that will play the role of personal assistant as well as interpreter tackling potential language barriers.
- Each High Level Advisers' goals will be linked to particular reform process. The
 continuity of the expert will be assessed once a year and its continuity will be linked
 to the achievement of his/her objectives. The EUHLA Mission shall constitute an
 instrument of constant policy dialogue.

Budgetary allocation: EUR 9-12 Million

<u>Duration of the contract:</u> 2-3 years.

Number of experts: 20-30 experts

Timeline:

- By 30 June 2015 Approval of final list of sectors (potentially including Security Sector Reform) and profiles of experts for the Mission.
- July 2015 DG NEAR will send the 20-30 job profiles to all EU National Contact Points for their consideration as well as for the proper dissemination of the information inside Member States as well as potential suitable candidates even if outside the Civil Service.
- September 2015 EU MS NCPs will be requested to provide feedback and potential candidates per post in the context of the Annual Institution Building Days (date to be determined).
- October 2015 Pre-selection of candidates.
- November 2015 Selection of high level advisers per each post and induction meeting with Moldovan counterpart.
- February/March 2016 Starting date of activities under High Level Advisory Mission.
