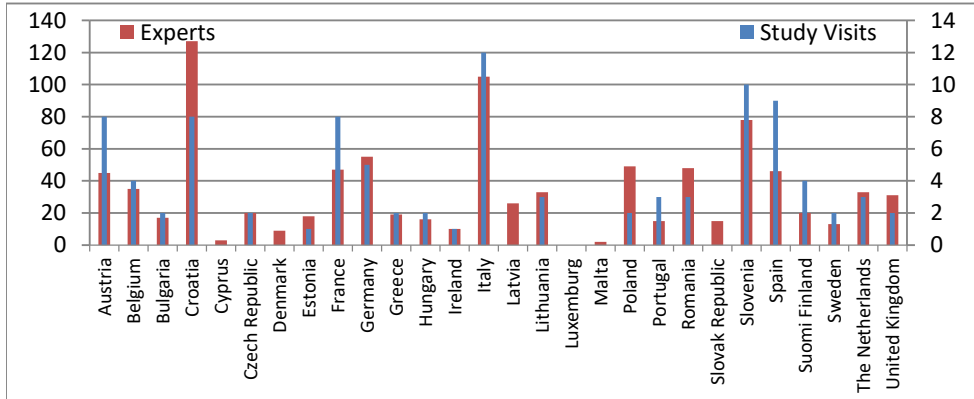

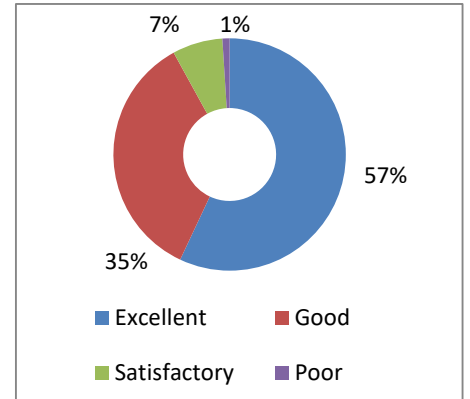

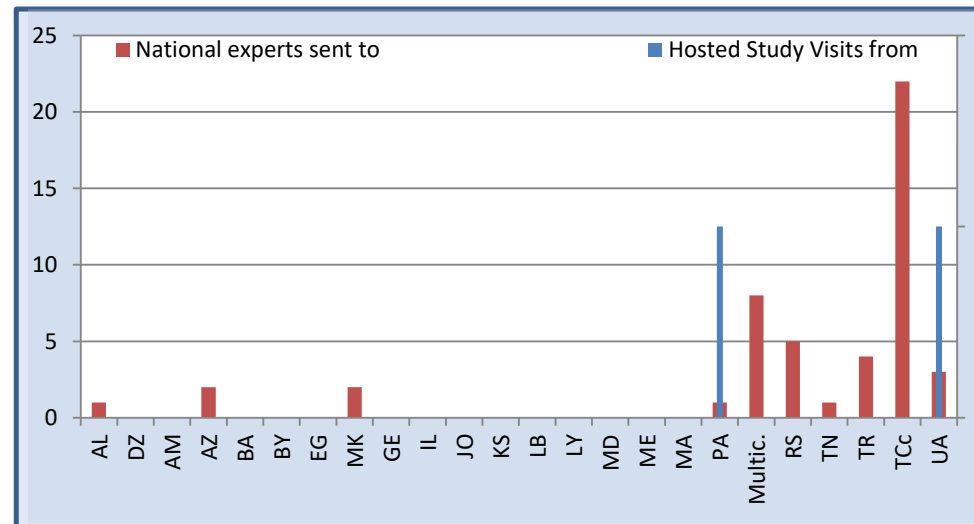
Number of Experts and Study Visits per Member State
